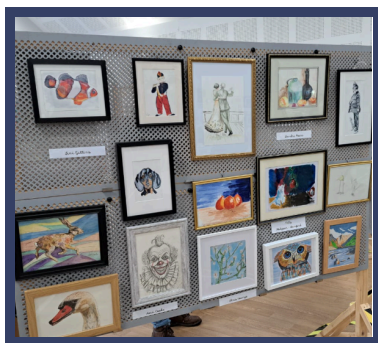
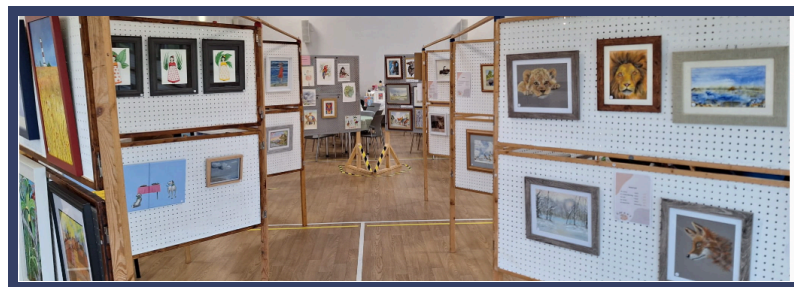


RECENT EVENTS

Our badminton sessions have been a great hit, with players of all abilities enjoying friendly competition and improving their skills. We're considering starting an evening session if a group leader steps forward.

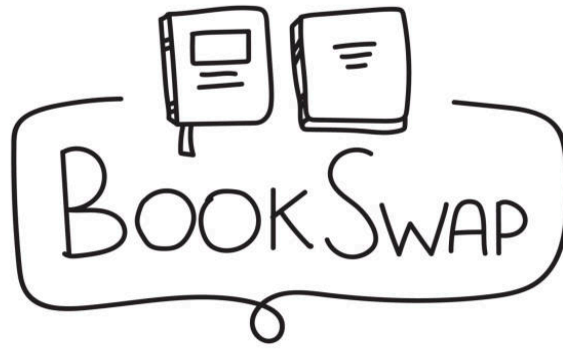
